Call to Order

SAA President Joe DiPompeo called the meeting to order at 6:17pm.

Guest Speaker

DiPompeo welcomed Russ Rogers, Director of Athletics. Rogers highlighted the changes that have taken place in the Athletics over the history of Stevens. He noted key achievements made by varsity student-athletes over the past year, as well as their stellar academic profile. Rogers commented on the vision for Athletics at Stevens moving forward, and he shared the six pillars by which they measure their success.

President's Report

DiPompeo welcomed Vicky Velasco, First Vice President, to the podium. Vicky then introduced the Greek student leaders who joined the SAA to network during the dinner.

Following the introduction of the students, DiPompeo welcomed Brodie Remington, Vice President of Development, to the podium. Remington reminded the members present that they had until February 17 to provide their feedback to the Mid-point Strategic Plan Review group. SAA members may share comments at spreview@stevens.edu.

Remington also offered updates regarding the move of the Alumni Office from the 9^{th} floor of the Howe Center to the 8^{th} floor.

DiPompeo asked Melissa Fuest, Assistant Vice President of Alumni Engagement and Annual Giving, whether there was a quorum of the Executive Committee present. Fuest confirmed that there was a quorum: six members of the SAA Executive Committee were present.

He then stated the purpose of the SAA: *The Stevens Alumni Association is formed to establish, maintain, and cultivate among its members a sentiment of regard for one another and of attachment*

to Stevens Institute of Technology, and to promote in every way the interests of the institute.

RESOLUTION: To approve the minutes from the December 5, 2016, meeting of the Executive Committee.

Motion – Leslie Brunell; Seconded – Joe Weber; Discussion – none; Vote – unanimous.

DiPompeo provided the Executive Committee with an update on the vote that is underway to amend the 1906 Constitution of the Stevens Alumni Association. DiPompeo noted that, in the month since the ballot had been mailed to 38,000+ alumni, only 337 ballots had been returned. He noted that Fuest had a comprehensive communications plan to help boost participation, but DiPompeo strongly encouraged all members of the Stevens Alumni Association to tell their friends to return the ballots before March 15.

DiPompeo then provided an update on the status of the draft of the new constitution. He noted that the appointed Constitution and Bylaws Committee of the Stevens Alumni Association has a meeting scheduled for Wednesday, February 15. At that meeting, they will begin the work of organizing the comments received from the lawyer hired by the SAA. He noted that the group was on track, and still had a goal of completing the work for the new Constitution by the end of June.

Classes Committee

Dick Magee shared the names of the members of the Classes Committee: Suzanne D'Addio, Mary Doddy, Tom Moschello, Marty Valerio, Melissa Fuest, George Johnston (co-chair), Dick Magee (co-chair).

He noted that the objective of the Committee is to increase class engagement by ensuring that each class has a viable and enthusiastic leadership team. Their goal for FY17 is to identify class leadership in the classes that end in a 3 or 8 from 1958 through 2013.

Magee then shared the status of their work to date. Currently, they have completed slates for seven classes: '58, '63, '68, '73, '88, '08, '13; Class Officer Orientation Presentation is completed; background information for Volunteers Presentation is completed.

Magee thanked members of the committee for their time and efforts. He also asked if anyone would volunteer to help finalize the remaining classes.

Clubs Committee

Keith Cassidy shared that the Clubs Committee has added a new member: Michael Cahill. He noted that they also developed a "strategy and goals" document that they plan to finalize and share at the March SAA meeting.

Cassidy shared the list of current clubs: DSAAC, Fishing Club, SMC, STEP Alumni, WAA; clubs in the works: APO, CPRA (Motorcycle Club), Honor Board, Khoda, Travel Club, Photography; as well as future ideas for clubs: Running Club, Video Game Club, and more.

Cassidy then provided updates on the activities of some of the current clubs. The DSAAC (Stevens Dramatic Society Alumni Affinity Club) continues to grow social media presence. They missed target of 100 "likes" by January 1, and they are working to define new target. The club also is promoting the Vagina Monologs Event on February 23.

Nominations Committee




Student and Alumni Engagement
